Veterans Plaza will allow residents of the greater Aledo community to honor veterans of all branches of the United States military, both living and deceased, for their service to our great nation. The plaza will feature a 35-foot circular memorial filled with memorial bricks honoring veterans. In the center will be a five-sided marble obelisk depicting each branch of the military standing 7-8 feet tall. On the outer perimeter will be three flags (U.S., Texas, POW/MIA). Several benches and public art pieces are planned. The site for the monument will be the Aledo Trail Park area across from city hall. Veterans Plaza is scheduled for completion by Veteran's Day 2016.
