Ladycats, Bearcats each lead in respective District 6-5A standings after wins <u>Staff Reports</u>

Paced by wins over Boswell and Northwest, the Aledo Ladycats and Bearcats are each alone in first place in District 6-5A.

Bearcats' Wins

On Tuesday at Bearcat Stadium, the Bearcats handled Boswell, 3-1.

Danny De La Cerda began the scoring when he found the back of the net on a penalty kick. The Bearcats extended their lead to 2-0 when Jarrod Nelson set up leading scorer Tanner VanCuren with a goal, and the 'Cats increased their lead to 3-0 on an unassisted goal by Max Owens. Boswell got on the board late in the match.

"It was a big win. It's huge to finish the first round of district at 7-0-0," Bearcats' head coach Derek Vierling said. "It puts us five points clear of second place. But it also puts a big target on our backs for the second round of district. We are going to have to continue playing with the same intensity and fundamentals to maintain what we did in the first round during the second round.

"Overall I was really pleased with our possession. The midfield kept control the majority of the game and we were able to get goals from three different guys. Boswell is a really good team, coming into the game with a 13-1-1 record having not lost since early

January. I'm really proud of the guys and the way they stepped up."

The Bearcats earned a huge road win with a 3-2 victory at Northwest on Feb. 10.

The game was tied 1-1 after the opening half, but the Bearcats scored a pair of goals in the second half while limiting the Texans to a goal to take a one-goal win. VanCuren, Alvero Huerta-Martin and Jarrod Nelson each scored a goal, with Max Owens collecting a pair of assists and De La Cerda adding a helper.

"It was a crazy game - really strong wind going goal to goal," Vierling said. "We scored first against the wind and really played well. They scored on a free kick just before halftime to tie the score.

"We had the wind the second

half and scored early on a corner kick then Mickey (Maloney) received a red card and we had to play the final 31 minutes down a player. We actually scored down a man making it 3-1 and then they scored just before the end of the game to make it 3-2 and make the final minute and half very nervy."

Ladycats' Wins


The Ladycats traveled to Boswell and came away with a 3-0 win. The big news was the return of junior goalkeeper Makenzie Covington, who recorded the shutout.

Boswell had a good game plan, keeping nine players behind the ball and leaving one up top. They were very defensive and worked hard. I was proud of our girls' effort and the way they battled."

Brooke Jones led the team with two assists, with Megan Crawford, Ashlee Ray and Laughley each earning an assist.
